Thank you for volunteering for the Kintetsu Parade.

Please meet at the Pearl City High School Bandroom at 2:30pm on June 10th. We will be taking a bus to and from Waikiki. We should return to Pearl City around 8:00pm.

We will be holding signs in the Pan-Pacific Festival Parade (Kintetsu Parade). The parade will start at Fort DeRussy, go down Kalakaua Avenue, and end at Kapiolani Park.

You are allowed to bring a small bag with you. Please DO NOT bring any valuables, as the band will not be liable for anything lost, stolen, or damaged.

Reminders:

- Please be sure to pack water and wear sunscreen.
- Wear comfortable covered shoes.
- Eat before you arrive at the bandroom, there will be no opportunity to eat while we are in Waikiki.
- Please wear a white T-Shirt or the marching band polo shirt. **We will have a Pan Pacific Festival shirt, which you will change into at the bandroom.** However, if we are short on T-shirts, the white shirt or marching band polo will suffice.
- You can wear shorts, but please be sure the length is appropriate – not too short.

If you would like to pick up your child from Waikiki please follow the instructions below:

1. Please send your child with a note stating that you will be picking your child up from Waikiki. Please state who will be picking up your child. Finally, please sign the note and provide us with a phone number which we can reach you at.
2. Your child will NOT be released until the person whose name is on the note is present to sign out your child.
